- The Government of Sindh has received credit through EAD, Govt. of Pakistan from the International Development Association and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for **Karachi Neighborhood Improvement Project (KNIP)** to perform the consulting services.
- Required consulting services namely DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISION & CONTRACT MANAGEMENT FOR CIVIL WORKS - Emergency Works (the Services) under the project, will cover but not limited to the following scope:
 - Detailed Survey, exploration, Coordination with utility companies, collecting and reviewing data on existing conditions of the Infrastructure, Preparation for base map, and preliminary conceptual designs.
 - Detailed Engineering/Urban Designs
 - Environmental and Social Impact Assessment.
 - Planning, Designing, Construction and Operation related ESMPs, social safeguard management, RAPs/ARAPs of Sub-Projects
 - Construction Supervision and Contract Management.
 - Field coordination with M&E consultant to monitor and evaluate the project by providing data and cooperating to deliver required progress reports etc.
 - Advise Karachi Neighborhood Improvement Project on project management and cost control measures.
 - Maintaining a high level of Quality Assurance & Quality Control to complete the projects in time, within the cost, and economical.
 - Stakeholder consultation and further identification of potential sub-projects
- The services are to be started by March 2021 and are expected to complete in 12 months time. Term of Reference for this consultancy services is available at www.knip.gos.pk.
- The Project Implementation Unit, Karachi Neighborhood Improvement Project, Planning and Development Department, Government of Sindh now invites consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the required services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have got the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are as under:

No.	Criteria
1.	Track Record: Corporate Capacity (Core business, number of offices and years in the same business, years in the Urban sector). Company brochure may be submitted with the Expressions of Interest to KNIP
2.	General Experience in providing services in Infrastructure Development under an urban setting. Five (05) development projects during the last Ten (10) years are required to be completed successfully. Mention the projects completed from January 2015 onwards.
3.	Relevant Experience of Design & Construction Supervision of successfully completing at least three (03) similar projects such as infrastructure, municipal streets, urban roads, parks & playground, parking plazas, and public space improvement during the last Ten (10) years (contracts completed in December 2015 onwards). The contract value of each contract should be Rs. 200 million or more.
4.	Overall Managerial/Design/Detailed Supervision Capacity (Core managerial and technical staff)
5.	The attention of interested consultants is drawn to Clause 3.16 and 3.17 Section III of the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers of July 2016 (revised in Nov 2017, August 2018, & Nov 2020) setting forth the World Bank's policy on Conflict of Interest.
6.	Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.
7.	A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant's Qualifications Based Selection (CQS) Method set out in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers of July 2016 (revised in Nov 2017, August 2018 & Nov 2020).
