Introduction

Karachi Neighborhood Improvement Project (KNIP) believes in inclusive approach for implementation of the sub-projects. In this regard, Public Consultation (PC) with stakeholders conducted in line with Work Bank's Operational Policy and Procedures. Stakeholders' Engagement is an integral part for meaningful consultation with the relevant stakeholders.
