



GENDER ACTION PLAN Karachi Neighborhood Improvement Project (KNIP)

Introduction:

A Gender Action plan (GAP) is a key gender mainstreaming tool. The purpose of GAP is to increase women participation and to provide maximum benefits of the project to women. A GAP should always be realistic with clear targets and achievable goals.

KNIP is a four-year joint project of Planning and Development Department Govt. of Sindh and the World Bank. The objective of the project is to enhance public spaces in target neighborhoods of Karachi and to improve city's capacity to provide selected administrative services. The project has three major components. According to the Project Appraisal Document of the project, a Gender Action Framework must be developed to ensure maximum benefits to the women in all three components of the project.

During a WB mission, it was decided that Gender Specialist will develop a draft Gender Action Plan and share with Social Development Specialist of the WB for review and approval. This GAP has been developed by keeping in mind the overall objective of the project. The Gender related initiatives have been proposed as realistic and achievable targets under all three major components of the project. This GAP ensures women participation in all stages of sub-projects i.e. Planning and design phase, Construction phase and Operational Phase.

One of the important aspects of the GAP is it focuses both Practical Gender Needs (PGNs) and Strategic Gender Needs (SGNs) of women. PGNs are those needs which are easy to identify and can easily address without any resistance such as in case of KNIP need of public toilets of women. SGNs are those need which cannot be easily identify and difficult to address such as sexual harassment in public spaces. In this GAP few initiatives have been suggested to curb this social crime by suggesting installation of emergency calling booth in public parks and bus stops of the vicinity of KNIP sub-project areas.

All the women-friendly initiatives which are proposed in the GAP will be ensured by developing checklists which will be designed separately for each sub-project. These checklists will be shared with the consultants such as women friendly design related checklist will be shared with design consultant before preparing design of sub-projects to ensure that all initiatives which are suggested in GAP are included in design.

However, estimated time lines are mentioned in time frame Colum.

³ The representation of women will ensure that all group of women include in consultations such as homemakers/housewife, working women (business and employed) literate and illiterate. Beside this, presentation of other vulnerable groups will also be ensured such as minorities and elderly.
