Terms of Reference (TOR) for Senior Civil & Transport Engineer

(Individual Consultant)

The service of **Senior Civil & Transport Engineer** as Individual Consultant in PIU (KNIP) will include but not limited to the following tasks:

- Facilitation, guidance and close coordination with the concerned consulting firm(s) and PIU team in preparation of the engineering designs, estimates, bidding documents for the civil works and transportation;
- 2. Evaluate/ review design reports submitted by the consultants regarding traffic pattern, proposed interventions, modes of transport, parking, roads and streets etc.
- 3. Coordination and Contribution for specific Engineering (Technical) aspects of Project in close coordination of PIU's Individual Consultants;
- 4. Close monitoring and follow-up of the progress of the construction contracts under execution;
- 5. Coordination with Project Supervision Consultant and Construction Contractors and other relevant agencies at field throughout the cycle of Project;
- 6. Close coordination with all the agencies/organizations providing the utility services in the project area to resolve the relevant issues promptly and amicably;
- 7. Initiate, organize and participate in coordination and progress meetings to review the Earned Value Performance Management (EVPM) throughout the works contracts execution;
- 8. Review the Construction Contractor's Invoices, Variation and Claims submitted after duly endorsement by Project Supervision Consultant in close coordination of relevant PIU's individual Consultants;
- 9. Advise PD/DPD PIU on the Performance of Project Supervision Consultant and Construction Contractors in close coordination with relevant PIU's individual Consultants:
- Report to Project Director and Deputy Project Director regarding all developments and implementation issues and progress of the civil works projects;
- 11. Field visits to examine and ensure development work (civil and transportation) as per approved design/contract;
- 12. Carry out any other project relevant task/duty assigned by the PD.

Qualification:

Postgraduate Degree in Civil Engineering, Transportation Planning & Management or any other similar discipline - with a minimum of 10 years of relevant post qualification experience. Working experience urban infrastructure and /or donor funded projects will be preferable.
